This staff member will be pivotal in developing followers who practice M-C-C. The role while broad in scope, falls into three critical areas:

Connect: *We experience Biblical community as we connect with others through weekly small groups, larger groups, and personal relationships.*

- Provide dynamic leadership; empowering, equipping and shepherding others to faithfully lead small groups.
- With Senior Minister, provide and maintain a library of small group materials and resources.
- Oversee coordination of bi-monthly Faith-In-Action and Body Life events (retreats, Memorial Day Picnic, hospitality evenings).
- Oversee New Member orientations.

Contribute: *We impact our world as we contribute to God's work through our gifts, talents, passions, and resources.*

- Evangelistic witness to the community with follow-up on MCC referrals and visitors.
- Equip members to be ministers and missional.
- Facilitate spiritual gifts development and follow-through, helping members to meaningfully contribute.

Communication/Administration:

- Development of church's publications, promotions, and communications through various media.
- Edit bulletin and website.
- Oversee, resource, and assist secretary in fulfilling her duties.

- Reports to the Senior Minister.
- A deep commitment to God and love for people.
- Capable and willing to align ministry with the MCC strategy.
- Equipped to equip others.
- Preference is married to an equally spiritually growing and pro-ministry spouse.
- Inclusive, called to serve a racially, economically, and religiously diverse community of people.
- Able to connect with young adults and young married couples.
- A demonstrated level of success and achievement in ministry that can be applied to the MCC church culture.
- Willing to receive accountability from the Senior Minister, Elders, and others as defined.
- Able to effectively communicate God's Word.
- Highly relational/approachable.
- A servant's heart. Willing to give and serve the community.
- Role model to all. Has an ability to garner respect and influence people as a spiritual leader for the good of the church.
